RULES FOR EXHIBITORS AT FLOWER SHOWS

1. Exhibits may be entered and registered at the Park Board Greenhouse, 38th Street and Bryant Avenue South on Saturday, September 18th, 1948 between 10 A. M. and 3:30 P. M. Positively not later.
2. Identification of each competing exhibit will be by official registration card, upon which the name of the exhibitor will be concealed until the judging is completed.
3. It is requested that, during judging, exhibitors do not enter the exhibition room until the judges have completed.
4. No exhibit may be removed until after 4:00 P. M., Sunday, September 19th, without permission of the Show Committee.
5. Exhibitor is not limited as to number of entries, but he will be permitted only one exhibit for competition in each Lot, except that in Lot 66 he will be permitted unlimited entries, providing the flowers are of different species and do not belong in some other Lot. If three or more entries of a specie are found in Lot 66, a new Lot number will be assigned.
6. If there should be any Lot in which there is less than three entries, the awards will be made on the merits of the entry. Or if in any Lot there are no entries worthy of an award, the judges may withhold any or all awards.
7. Lots 75 to 86 inclusive, will be judged for arrangement, quality of material, color combination, workmanship, relation of materials to container.
8. Lots 1 to 66 inclusive, will be exhibited in containers provided by the Committee, except Lot 65.
9. A ribbon will be awarded for each first, each second, and each third selection by the judges in every Lot. A Grand Champion ribbon will be awarded to the one best exhibit in each Group. A Sweepstakes will be awarded to the exhibitor having the greatest number of points, based on three points for first place, two points for second place, and one point for third place in each Lot from 1 to 74 inclusive, and six points for first place, four points for second place, and two points for third place in each of the Lots 75 to 86.  
  
Court of Honor ribbons will be awarded to not more than ten meritorious exhibits.
10. Decisions of the judges will be final.
11. All entries must have been grown by the exhibitor.
